

RED HAT ENTERPRISE VIRTUALIZATION FOR DESKTOPS: PRICING QUICKGUIDE

AT A GLANCE

- RHEV for Desktops is an add-on for RHEV for Servers
 - If you need desktop operating systems in your VMs or you are supporting users connecting to desktops through SPICE, you need RHEV for Desktops
 - Just count the number of concurrent desktop users and buy enough RHEV for Desktops to support your peak load
 - Desktop operating systems not included
 - Just count your concurrent desktop users, choose your SLA, and go!
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RED HAT ENTERPRISE VIRTUALIZATION FOR DESKTOPS SUBSCRIPTION MODEL

Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Desktops (RHEV for Desktops) is an add-on to your existing Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Servers (RHEV for Servers) subscription. Desktops are licensed on a per-concurrent-desktop basis, in packs of 25 concurrent desktops. The subscription includes support for supported desktop operating systems, the SPICE remote rendering protocol, the Connection Broker, and for supported thin clients and PC browsers on Linux and Microsoft Windows platforms.

This model allows customers to freely mix server and desktop virtual machines without requiring segregation of desktop and server workloads for licensing purposes. Desktop operating system licenses from Microsoft, Red Hat, or other providers must be licensed separately.

RHEV FOR DESKTOPS PRODUCTS

- Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Desktops, 25 concurrent desktops pack, Standard (business hour support) \$325/year (US List Price)
- Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization Desktops, 25 concurrent desktops pack, Premium (24x7 support) \$563/year (US List Price)

PRICING EXAMPLE

Purchasing RHEV for Desktops is easy. Here is an example:

This customer has ten (10) servers with two (2) sockets each running as hypervisors, and a single two (2) socket server for the RHEV Manager. They have already purchased RHEV for Servers subscriptions for each hypervisor. Desktop operating systems are running on five (5) of the servers. The maximum number of concurrent desktop users is 250. (See Figure 1 below.) The customer is deploying in production and wants 24x7 support.

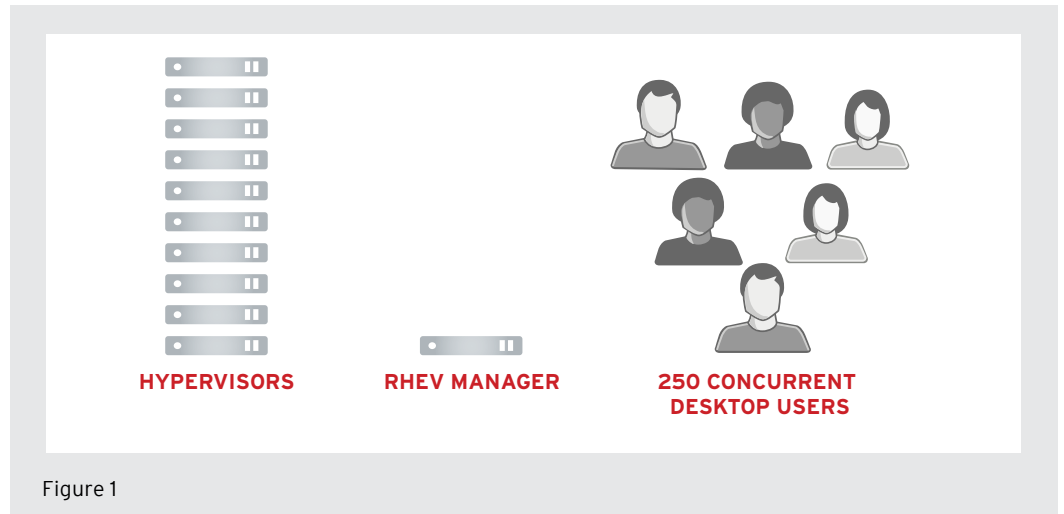
To support 250 concurrent desktop users, we need 10 packs of 25 concurrent desktops. The customer needs to select RHEV for Desktops Premium because they need 24x7 support.

FOUR EASY STEPS

1. Make sure your hypervisors are all licensed for RHEV for Servers
2. Count the maximum number of concurrent desktop users who will be connecting at any one time
3. Choose your support level (Business hours or 24x7)
4. Purchase enough RHEV for Desktops 25 pack subscriptions in either Standard or Premium for the number of users
